



EnrichAbility eligibility criteria

Our Aim

To enable those living with a physical disability, within the county of Oxfordshire, to become socially involved within their communities.

How we work

We aim to be as inclusive as we can be. We will assess each referral on an individual basis.

We will work with people if they will benefit from our service and where we have the skills to support them.

If we do not have the necessary skills to support someone, or we feel they will be better supported by another organisation, we will signpost them to the most appropriate organisation for their needs, if such an organisation exists within their geographical area.

These are our minimum eligibility criteria:

We can support adults who are...

- Living with a physical disability that affects their ability to take part in the activities of their choice
- At risk of experiencing isolation and loneliness as a result of disability • Living in the geographical area covered by our service

And...

- The activity is appropriate for the person and is in the area of leisure or learning
- The person is willing to work with us and share relevant information to help us understand their needs and how to support them
- It must be possible for the activity to take place in an environment that is safe for everyone involved

Please note

- We may decline referrals for people whose disability is age-related, as there are specific organisations funded to provide this support in the county.
- We may decline referrals for people whose living arrangements already include an element of social support (eg people living in a care home)
